agree to support the Mission, Vision, and Goal as stated herein. The SHSP Executive Committee for purpose of this MOU shall consist of the Chief Executive Officer of the above named agencies and organizations or his/her designee.

MISSION : *Provide a safe, efficient and cost effective transportation system that meets the mobility needs and safety of all users*

VISION : *All users of the transportation system move safely and effectively to their destination*

GOAL : *Achieve a reduction in serious crashes, injuries and fatalities on Puerto Rico roadways*

NOW, THEREFORE, the SHSP Executive Committee, as signatories hereto, jointly agree to the following:

1. Hold joint meetings as needed, but not less than once every year, to ensure adequate progress towards achieving the SHSP goals and highway safety initiatives.
2. Appoint staff to serve on committees and to assist as necessary with the implementation of the SHSP strategies.
3. Provide guidance on the implementation of transportation safety policies and on transportation safety related issues in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico..
4. Align and coordinate agency resources, programs, and projects to achieve SHSP goals for Puerto Rico.

This MOU can be revised by the SHSP Executive Committee voting members upon the majority vote of those signatory members attending a meeting of the SHSP Executive Committee. This MOU shall become effective upon its execution by all authorized signatories and shall remain effective through September 30, 2018.
