Data Driven Decisions

- **An SHSP is an essential and required component of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)**
 - Data-driven, statewide plan that:
 - Identifies State's priority roadway safety needs
 - Provides a comprehensive framework for reducing highway fatalities and serious injuries
 - Includes behavioral and infrastructure priorities and strategies

SHSP Background

Transforms how states address roadway safety needs

- Development led by the state DOT in *consultation* with local, state, tribal, federal and private-sector safety stakeholders
- Addresses *4 E's of highway safety*
- Considers safety needs of *all public roads*
- Describes *emphasis areas and effective strategies* to reduce or eliminate roadway safety hazards
- Guides *investment decisions* for safety projects
